



Palisade Gardens and James Club Residents, Families and Friends

As the province has moved into phase three of the reopening, we would like to provide an update on what this means for the residents and families of Palisade Gardens and James Club.

In phase two in suite visits were implemented. A reminder that all visitors must screen in at the front door prior to entry, masks **MUST** be worn for the duration of the visit, social distancing of 6ft even in suites and visitors must go directly to the resident's suite. Visitors are not permitted to go throughout the building. All visitors entering the building must wear a medical mask. Those visiting in our outside designated area must wear a medical or cloth mask.

The dividers have been removed from the tables in the dining room allowing four residents at a table. Please note only residents are permitted to be in the dining room for meals.

As we now enter phase three, fully vaccinated staff, essential caregivers and all visitors are no longer required to be covid tested, unless presenting with Covid 19 symptoms. For all partially or unvaccinated staff and essential care providers weekly testing for Covid 19 is required.

Fully vaccinated resident's who are gone on overnight visits or hospital stays as well as new move ins are no longer required to be tested upon return. Partially or unvaccinated resident's and new move ins who are gone overnight are required to have a PCR test upon returning and must isolate until negative results are received.

The Shuttle Bus will resume operation next week with a limited capacity of 4 residents at a time. Residents are required to sign up at the reception desk. The bus will run on Tuesdays and Thursdays. For more information, please contact Brittney, activity director.
